Contract Allocation for July 1, 2019

At the Regular May Union Meeting the Membership voted to allocate the \$1.00 contractual raise as follows:

\$.50 on the Wage,
Increasing the wage from \$39.55 to \$40.05

\$.40 on the Health & Welfare,
Increasing H & W from \$9.40 to \$9.80

\$.10 on the Pension,
Increasing Pension from \$6.10 to \$6.20

All other Contributions remain the same.

The membership also voted to contribute \$.10 to the UA Organization Fund that will start on July 1, 2019.

UA Scholarship Fund Information:

The United Association Scholarship Trust Fund is gearing up for the 2019/2020 academic year scholarship awards. Up to 112 scholarships totaling as much as \$222,000 will be awarded this year, including 106 for students pursuing undergraduate studies and up to six for students pursuing graduate studies. Scholarships range from \$1,500 to \$5,000 each. Generally, dependents of UA members who are pursuing a post-high school education at an accredited college or university may apply for a scholarship (please see eligibility requirements and award criteria in the detailed instructions found with the application). **The deadline for submitting applications is June 1, 2019.**

With this year's scholarship cycle, we are excited to announce a new electronic application process. Applications will now **only** be accepted electronically through <https://uascholarshipfund.communityforce.com/>. Potential applicants will need to go to that website to create a user account and for additional instructions to access and submit applications.

Note: Applications may not be available until as late as March 1, 2019.

In addition, six scholarships will be given to six "Second Chance" applicants. Those selected will be students whose academic achievement is not the best in their region, but rather students who demonstrate that they want another chance at an education that will help them get a good paying job.

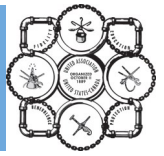
When you have been laid off, it is your responsibility to inform the Hall. Please call to let us know your lay-off date. This includes members who have been traveling.
