Keeping track of your Union Dues Payment is as simple as marking a calendar and it prevents a lot of needless trouble for members and Union Office Staff alike. All to often members fall into dues delinquency, and incur additional costs upon themselves, not because of long term financial difficulties, but simply through poor record keeping.

But whatever the reason, falling behind on your monthly dues is bad news; and members have to follow the rules of the United Association to return to good standing. Any member who falls more than three months behind in dues payment automatically becomes delinquent. NO notification is required. Delinquent members are not entitled to any Union right, privileges or monetary benefits. (See UA Constitution Booklet, page 103, Sec. 157)

A delinquent member returns to good standing by paying a \$50 reinstatement fee, <u>PLUS</u> all back dues through the current month (\$144). The back dues cannot be paid until the reinstatement fee are paid in full.

REMINDERS:

When you have been laid off, it is your responsibility to inform the Hall. Please call to let us know your lay-off date. This includes members who have been traveling.

courtesy, but also necessary
that you call the Business
Manager of that particular

at our Hall.


A locked Drop-Box is located adjacent to the Administrative Office Doors. Anyone needing to drop off union dues payments, confidential paperwork, etc. after hours is encouraged to use the box as it is checked every morning.

PENSION:

If you are thinking about retiring, please notify the Pension Fund about three months before your retirement date. You can request an Estimate prior to retiring. Also Normal Age of Retirement changed to age 62 for active participants.

NEW ONLINE DUES PAYMENT

Plumbers and Pipefitters have recently added a new feature to the webpage: www.ualocal101.org. The new feature will allow members to log into a private member only area. To log into this area, go to the website and find the log in tab.



Once you have clicked the tab you will be required to log into this area. Your username is your UA card number, you must have two zeros before your card number. Your password will be your birthday in the following format: MMDDYYYY.



When you enter the member only area you should see your contact information, your Union Dues paid thru and three tabs at the bottom of the page. Those tabs are your skills, job history and pay online.



Pay online will allow you to go online and pay your monthly Union Dues. Click the pay online tab, it will take you to the payment screen. From there, you will add how many months you want to pay by clicking the add dues charge. Check the boxes to add to cart and enter your payment information, make sure to submit payment.
