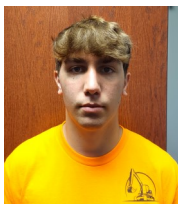


Congratulations to Jeff Thornton on his retirement. Jeff retired on April 1st, 2023. Enjoy your retirement and hope to see you at the lunches.

Covers Tetanus, Diphtheria, & Pertussis (Whooping Cough).
Free to Fund Participants. Non-Fund Participant Fee: \$90

EXISTING Users: enter username (email) & password

Once registered for an approved, walk-in clinic, you'll receive an email with your lab paperwork, plus confirmation of the approved clinic name, hours & location. No co-pay, insurance information, nor appt required. Just bring your photo ID, your lab paperwork (printed or on your smartphone), & wear a mask.
